

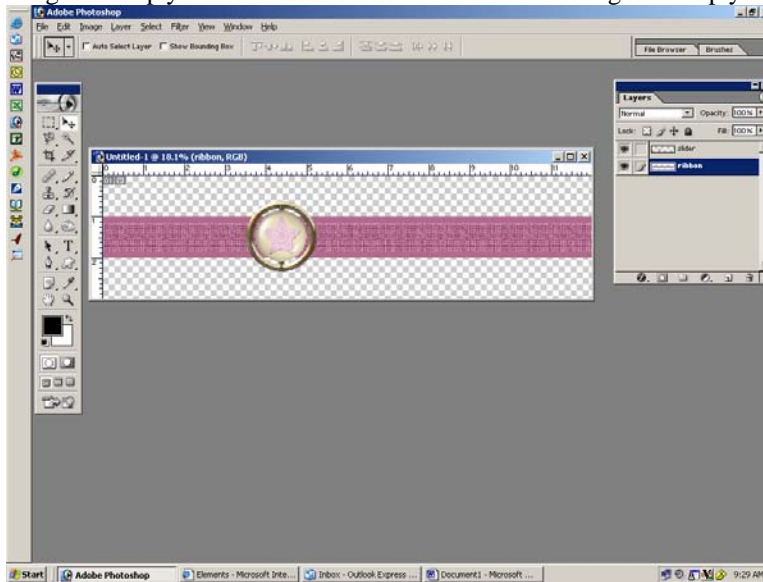
THREADING SLIDERS / BUCKLES ON RIBBONS – PHOTOSHOP TUTORIAL

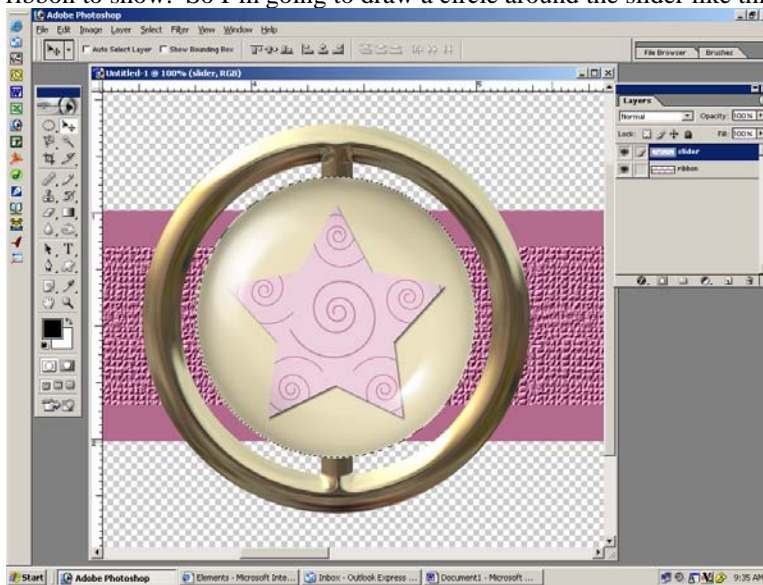

Open up the ribbon you want to use and open up the slider or buckle you want to use. Create a NEW document that is 12” long by about 2-3” in height (depending on how big you want your slider and ribbon to be).

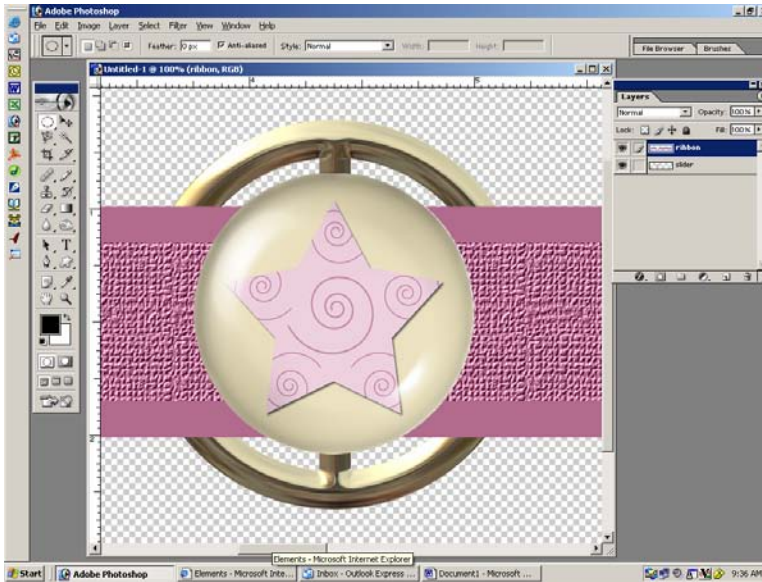
Drag and drop your ribbon onto the new document. Drag and drop your slider on top of the ribbon.



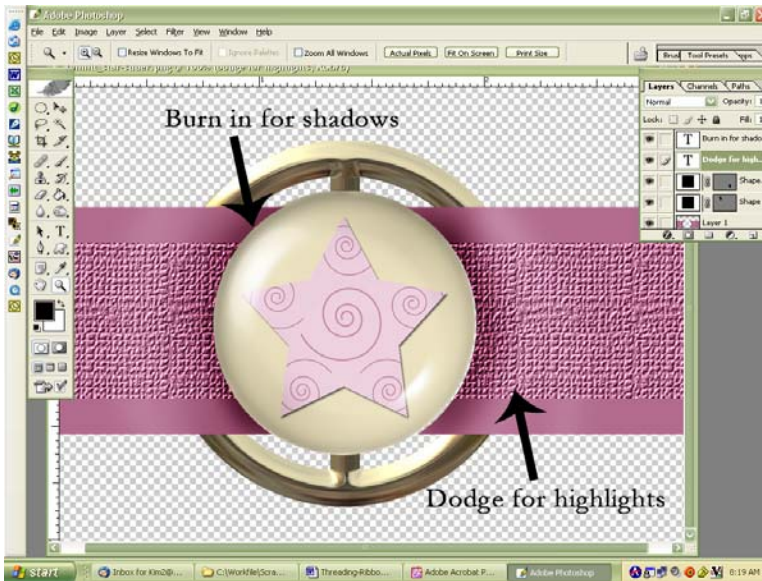
Grab your zoom tool and zoom in nice and close to the slider so you can really see what you are doing. Now grab your circle selection tool. You will need to select the area of the slider where you want no ribbon to show. So I'm going to draw a circle around the slider like this.



Keep the dashed selection line in place, but move the ribbon to the TOP layer and then press the delete key. VOILA! You now have your slider on a ribbon.



You can now use the burn and dodge tools to add a little more realism. Then add a drop shadow if you want, too!



You're done!
